There is now a defibrillator in a cabinet on the wall outside Tesco in Weston High Street. It has been jointly provided by B&NES Council and More to Life, with the support of the Community Heartbeat Trust.

If someone has suffered a cardiac arrest, then this is what to do...

- 1 Call 999 and ask for the South West Ambulance Service. Tell them where you are.
- 2 They will give you a special code. Key this code into the keypad on the cabinet and it will open.
- 3 Get out the defibrillator. The Ambulance Service will tell you what to do.

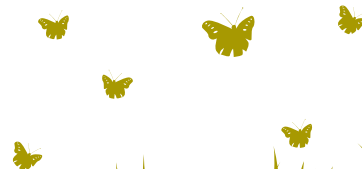
