Winter WestFest

Saturday 10 December Events from 11am to 6pm

Following the huge success of **Winter WestFest 2014**, the event is to be held in Weston again this year with lots of activities and events planned for the day: Carol Singing, Christmas Fayre, Christmas Tree Festival, Lantern Procession, Live Music, Bell Ringing and much more. However the activities start well before this date with a Christmas Trail commencing in November...

Remember the Christmas Lost Sheep Trail in Weston & Newbridge two years ago? This year there is to be another Trail. In lots of places (mostly shops) in Weston & Newbridge, there will be a Christmas picture. Together they will tell the story of the first Christmas. The challenge will be to find all the pictures and answer the questions in the booklet that can be bought in the schools and other places. 'On the road to Bethlehem' can be done by all ages - not just children. Prizes for winning entries will be given out in All Saints Church at the end of Winter WestFest.

Here's a list of events and times for 10 December:

11am to 4pm Christmas Fayre at All Saints Centre packed with stalls selling crafts, gifts and produce and also including refreshments, children's games and activities, craft work, and displaying and selling the knitted poppies.

11am to 6pm Christmas Tree Festival in All Saints Church also including live music

4.15pm Carols round the Christmas Tree (at the junction of High Street and Trafalgar Road)

4.45pm Lantern Procession to All Saints Church, accompanied by bell ringing

4.50pm Refreshments in church (free)

5pm onwards Competition winners announced ('On the road to Bethlehem' trail and 'Christmas Tree Festival') plus there will be a short talk about the trail.

Admission cost for the Christmas Tree Festival and Christmas Fayre just £1.00 for Adults, 50p for Children with under 5's free. (This includes a 'glow in the dark' wristband)

Remembrance Sunday Service

Sunday 13 November

10.45am at the War Memorial in
Weston High Street

Remembrance Sunday is the second Sunday in November, the Sunday nearest to 11 November, which is Remembrance Day, also known as Armistice Day or sometimes Poppy Day. On the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918, the guns of the Western Front fell silent after more than four years of continuous warfare during the First World War. In many parts of the world, people observe a two-minute silence at 11am every 11 November, to remember those who lost their lives during the First World War as well as in more recent conflicts. From 2014 to 2018, this day takes on added significance as it marks the centenary of the First World War.

We will observe a two minute silence at 11am at our joint churches service on Sunday 13 November held at the War Memorial. There will also be hymns accompanied by the band of the Boys Brigade – 2nd Bath Company and readings and prayers.

In addition, people in Weston and the local area have been working hard on producing a Remembrance Day Community Tribute – ‘Field of Poppies’ The tribute will be on display at this service, but was exactly is it?

The ‘Field of Poppies’ was started by the Weston & Corston Knit and Natter Group who meet monthly in one another’s homes to share their enjoyment of making and of course chatting. They decided to get as many people involved as possible and knit or crochet 1200 poppies, so for the last few months families and friends have been very busy knitting and crocheting. The count is already over 750 at the time of going to press, so just 450 more to make before Remembrance Sunday!

The project is designed to raise money for the Royal British Legion and has grown way beyond the original Knit and Natter Group to encompass the community of Weston including All Saints Church, local schools, the Love Weston Café, and shops on Weston High Street. There are now over 80 makers, including one lady in Tenerife! The youngest maker is just 5 and the oldest in their nineties. £100 was raised for charity from the sale of tea and cakes at a drop-in workshop at All Saints Centre in September at which over 60 people attended.

All the poppies will be attached to two large fabric panels and these will be displayed on Weston High Street by the War Memorial on Remembrance Sunday and afterwards in All Saints Church and then at other venues in Weston village. The poppies will then be available to buy as brooches in aid of the Royal British Legion at the Winter WestFest on Saturday 10th December. **For more information see facebook/westonpoppies.com**

There is a defibrillator in a cabinet on the wall outside Tesco in Weston High Street. It has been jointly provided by B&NES Council and More to Life, with the support of the Community Heartbeat Trust.

If someone has suffered a cardiac arrest, then this is what to do...

- 1 Call 999 and ask for the South West Ambulance Service. Tell them where you are.
- 2 They will give you a special code. Key this code into the keypad on the cabinet and it will open.
- 3 Get out the defibrillator. The Ambulance Service will tell you what to do


